"Fundraising Policy"

Purpose:

To clearly communicate the requirements necessary to have volunteer cheques returned. Fundraising is a very important part of the club to ensure club fees stay down for all registrants, and it is strongly encouraged that families participate in all or as many events as possible.

Policy:

- There will be a minimum of three fundraising activities during the swim season. Working one of these specific fundraisers is worth one \$100 cheque. E.g. Bottle Drive, selling Raffle tickets
- The club has 2 mini meets per swim season. Volunteering at one is worth half of a volunteer cheque per family member (up to two members).
- When organized, volunteering in the party room to watch the children of those volunteering at a mini meet, is worth a half volunteer cheque.
- In some years, taking a course (to be pre-determined by the board) and working one shift, will count towards a volunteer cheque. This will not be available every year, but will depend on what additional training is necessary to fill positions at the club's swim meet.
